# **How Jesus Cares**

Henry Moorhouse, a 19th-century English evangelist, was feeling loaded down with the burdens of his ministry. Then the Lord gave him a tender reminder of His care.

When he came home one day, his young daughter, Minnie, whose legs were paralysed, was sitting in her wheelchair. He was going to take a package upstairs to his wife when his daughter asked if she could carry it.

Moorhouse said, "Minnie dear, how can you possibly carry this package? You cannot even carry yourself." With a smile on her face, Minnie said, "I know, daddy. But if you will give me the package, I will hold it while you carry me."

This is a beautiful illustration of what God wants to do for all of us if only we will trust Him, just as Minnie trusted her father. One thing is certain, Jesus Christ cares for you. What are some of the ways He expresses His love and concern?

#### **JESUS DARES**

"... That He by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone" (Hebrews 2:9b).

Many people resist making a decision for Christ for one reason or another. They go to great lengths to avoid any involvement which might cost them time and effort.

Jesus dared to get involved. At Calvary He became our sin bearer. He paid the debt for us by giving His own life. "Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures" (1 Corinthians 15:3).

### **JESUS SHARES**

"He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves..." (2 Corinthians 5:15).
